<p>Update on Letters to Boards and membership</p>	<p>-letters have been sent out to Boards (Directors) with Oasphe representation to say “thank you” and also letters have been sent if Boards do not have representation to ask for representation on Oasphe and the importance of it. To date we have at least 4 new members that have come out of the letters. - letters are being held for Boards who have been invoiced or have not yet paid but have indicated that payment is in process</p>	<p>Ann to send out letters as payments are made</p>
<p>Advocacy: Sharing of the latest advocacy letter - “Great to Excellent” MOE Consultation - Ophea Crowdsourcing</p>	<p>Both Oasphe and Ophea sent a letter to the Premier advocating AGAIN for the release of the curriculum. OASPHE letter is attached to minutes. -just over \$ 10,000 raised for the Ophea Crowdsourcing Campaign, enough to have a posting in the newspapers - Joanne also had an opportunity to appeal for the full release of the HPE curriculum via the subject association reports during the morning of the EDU meeting as well as via the “Great to Excellent” consultation session that occurred during the afternoon of the EDU meeting.</p>	
<p>DPA Research by PHO</p>	<p>-the Ministry has a Support and Monitoring Plan (looking at healthy schools, concussion plans); Auditor General is also doing an audit of healthy schools; Research by Public Health Ontario on DPA in schools. Research to begin in January. 40 School Boards have been approached. Ministry of Education and CODE have supported this research. Interestingly it didn’t seem like anyone on the call had heard about this research being conducted in their Boards.</p>	

<p>Agenda items for the joint meeting, Ophea/OASPHE Nov. 27th</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - CAPL/Physical Literacy – presentation of our key fitness messages and how they will fit into what is happening; Passport for Life from PHE Canada – they must be supported by quality resources, not an entity on its own as a fitness test - secondary support documents – feedback, curriculum is not being released, what can we do moving forward – Joanne, Tammy, Lara to review - review of Playsport – secondary focus – presentation of the program, individuals will be asked to support further development, looking at one Playsport for all grades - gym timetabling - #'s of students in the gym - Safety Guidelines – concussion protocols, a draft PPM is coming out from the Ministry which will help school boards move forward, essential that school boards follow the appropriate protocol (few edits required: date of visit, name of doctor)
