	<p>Presenters will be provided with these foci and asked to ensure that their presentation fits into one of the four.</p> <p>The workshop template that is attached to the Conference Planning document is a working document and a template. Not much is set in stone, but it is a start looking at themes and space availability.</p> <p>Concern was brought up around the “experiential learning options” in the 3rd foci. What do people think that means? Dave wanted it to focus on High Skills Major, Focus courses, investigative learning (inquiry) rather than field trips and guest speakers. Language may need to be looked at here to ensure people understand what is being offered.</p> <p>Are there enough active sessions? Consensus was “yes”. We just need to ensure that presenters that are presenting these sessions at both OASPHE and CIRA have a different focus.</p> <p>Do we look at moving the Show and Share somewhere else so folks don’t take off at the end of the day?</p> <p>Look at maybe extending the lunch and allow people to go to the Show and Share, Carolyn’s student’s poster presentation, or the marketplace.</p> <p>Do we need a workshop on “how to handle the tough questions?” and creating an atmosphere of trust? We would need to be very careful and scripted and ensure we don’t get into content issues. If we offer this, focus should be on consent, healthy relationships, trust and decision making.
